 - University of Maryland, College Park, MD (Department of Civil & Environmental Engineering)
- Be pursuing an Undergraduate (sophomore level or higher), Graduate, or advanced degree in any of the following disciplines: Civil Engineering, Construction Management, Material Sciences, Architecture, or relevant technical disciplines.
- Be in good academic standing with your Institution.
- Have a 3.0 (or greater) GPA at the time of application submission.
- Application signed, completed, and submitted electronically with a copy of the applicant's resumé and unofficial transcripts to the ACI Maryland Chapter no later than July 1st, 2023, to the attention of Mindy Green, MRMCA: <u>Admin@aci-md.org</u>

SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION:

- Scholarship amount(s) to be awarded are up to \$10,000 U.S. which could be split between candidates at the decision and discretion of the ACI Maryland Chapter Board.
- Student(s) will be notified within two (2) weeks from the application submission deadline via email.
- Awarded amounts will be paid in "Check" form to the selected students on or before August 15th, 2023.
- Completion and Submission of Application does not guarantee a Scholarship award.
- Selection of Student(s) for a scholarship is based on a thorough review of Applications by the Board Members
 of the ACI Maryland Chapter in an unbiased manner.
- Decisions made by the ACI Maryland Chapter Board will be "final" and not subject to secondary reviews or consideration.
- Scholarship recipients can utilize the funds for Tuition and/or Book fees associated with your school program, or any projects associated with your curriculum requirements in the construction materials industry.
- Scholarship recipients will be required to complete and return a W-9 form to ACI Maryland Chapter for tax purposes.
- Although not a mandatory requirement, scholarship recipients are encouraged to share with ACI Maryland Chapter any information on the projects or activities where the funds have been utilized.
- ACI Maryland Chapter retains the right to publicize information on the Scholarship recipient(s) and/or how their funds were utilized.
